BLOODY MAN I told ya...the boat was empty. I tore it apart and there was nothing there.

PAPA LUIGI Who owns the boat?

BLOODY MAN Some guy named Max.

PAPA LUIGI What's his last name?

BLOODY MAN

I don't know.

Sal takes a batter's stance and swings at the man's legs. He howls in pain.

PAPA LUIGI Did I tell you to hit him again?

SAL No...I...thought you wanted him to talk.

PAPA LUIGI I'll do the thinking. You do as I say. He can't finish my boat with broken legs, you idiot! BLOODY MAN All I know is he runs an export business in Connecticut. Please don't hit me again.

PAPA LUIGI If you're lying to me...we'll be back. (to his boys) Let's go. (beat; to the man) Sorry about that last whack... (drops a wad of cash in the man's lap) For you doctor's bill...

CUT TO:

EXT. A MIDDLE-CLASS HOME IN THE SUBURBS - ESTABLISHING - MORNING

The house is decorated for Christmas. Several different ALARM CLOCKS BLAST the silence.

INT. JASPER AND AMANDA'S BEDROOM

JASPER KROGH slams the "off" button on the alarm clock, notices his wife's appealing position and snuggles into her; he's feeling frisky.

AMANDA pushes him away.

AMANDA It's Wednesday, Jasper.

JASPER Can't blame a guy for trying...

He rolls out of bed, passes a beautiful scale model of a fully-rigged sailboat mounted on the wall as he heads for the bathroom.

INT. HALLWAY - LATER

Jasper exits his bedroom to find TRIP, his hormonal 13-yearold son, peering through a crack in the door into his sisters' bedroom. INT. THE TWIN'S BEDROOM - TRIP'S P.O.V.

CANDY and SANDY, 15-year-old identical twins, are putting on makeup. When they are done, they aren't identical anymore.

CANDY If John asks you to the movies, I think you should say you have other plans...

SANDY But I want to go out with him...

CANDY You have to play hard to get...

ON TRIP AND JASPER

JASPER Trip, stop spying on your sisters.

TRIP (still looking) I'm not spying.

JASPER What are you doing then?

TRIP

Learning.

JASPER Learn somewhere else.

Jasper opens a door that has a large sign on it that reads "DO NOT ENTER" beneath a picture of a skull and cross-bones.

INT. CLIFFORD'S BEDROOM - CONTINUOUS

Filled with a mass of electronic equipment. Someone is buried under the blankets; SNORING loudly.

Jasper pulls the blankets off CLIFFORD, a 17-year-old nerd with scraggly long hair, wearing Star Trek pajama bottoms and no shirt. His eyebrow is pierced.

JASPER Rise and shine, pal. (wrinkles his nose) And take a shower. You smell like...bad. As Jasper leaves the room, Cliff shoots him "the bird."

INT. KITCHEN - LATER

Jasper ENTERS the kitchen, now dressed in a conservative suit and tie. Cliff and Trip are sitting at the kitchen table eating cereal.

Amanda hands Jasper a cup of coffee, which he takes a slug of, burning his throat.

JASPER HOT! HOT! HOT!

AMANDA It's helps to blow on it first, honey.

Trip snickers from the table. Cliff ignores him.

Sandy and Candy ENTER the kitchen, now dressed in sexy outfits, although totally different. Candy's is pink and frilly while Sandy's is all black.

They move together in a weird synchronicity common to identical twins, although they try to hide this trait whenever possible: one gets out two glasses, while the other gets juice from the refrigerator and pours.

> JASPER You're not wearing that to school... are you?

CANDY/SANDY (simultaneously) Yes. Why?

JASPER It's kind of short...

CANDY Our cheerleading uniforms are shorter than this.

SANDY Get with it, Dad. This is how all the girls dress.

CLIFFORD The slutty girls...

CANDY/SANDY We heard that! JASPER Amanda, help me here?

AMANDA Clifford, that's not nice. Girls, I think you look cute. Jasper, would you like some breakfast?

JASPER

Gotta run...I want to drop by a client's before I go to the office... He's not returning my calls for some reason.

AMANDA Don't forget I have writing class tonight and some Christmas shopping... (rubs fingers together)

Jasper pulls out his wallet and hands Amanda some money.

The kids grab their book bags and jackets and stand in line during the following...

CLIFFORD And my technology club meets tonight... There's dues... (puts his hand out)

Jasper hands him a \$20.

CANDY We have a game...

SANDY ...and everyone is going out after to the Big Burger.

Jasper hands them each \$20.

TRIP And I'm going to the new Transformers movie...

Jasper hands Trip the last \$20 bill from his now empty wallet. He's cleaned out.

AMANDA (kissing Jasper's cheek) Looks like you're on your own tonight, hon. JASPER Looks like it.

CUT TO:

EXT. THE GIANNI EXPORT/IMPORT OFFICE - DAY

Jasper pulls his late model SUV into the parking lot behind the building. A red Corvette is parked next to the back door. Jasper opens the back door to the building and steps inside.

INT. THE BUILDING - CONTINUOUS

Jasper steps into a large very dark room filled with all kinds of boxes. No one is there. Jasper stumbles through the dark interior, hears a NOISE coming from an open door where a light is on.

INT. GIANNI'S OFFICE - CONTINUOUS

MAX GIANNI, short, balding, overweight, is hurriedly throwing things from his desk into a box.

JASPER (V.O.) Hey, Max. What's up?

MAX (startled) Jesus, Jasper! You scared the shit outta me.

JASPER Sorry. What're you doing?

MAX Going on a trip.

Max puts a golfing trophy into the box.

JASPER When will you be back?

MAX

Dunno.

JASPER A week? Two weeks? Next year?

MAX Maybe never. 6.

JASPER Never? What about the money you owe me?

MAX I don't have it.

JASPER

Max, that was my kid's college education! Retirement for me and my wife! Max, I took out a second mortgage on my house!

MAX I'm sorry, Jasper. I kinda got in over my head.

JASPER What does that mean - over your head?

MAX

I lost it.

JASPER You what!? How does someone lose two hundred thousand dollars!?

MAX I was winning. At one point, I doubled your money. But then...

JASPER Then what?

men what:

MAX My luck turned... lost everything on the Dallas game. (shakes head) God damned Cowboys!

JASPER

I loaned you that money to invest in a business deal with the Chinese! A sure thing that was supposed to make both of us rich!

Max grabs the box, pushes past Jasper, and heads out the door. Jasper follows.

MAX A sure thing don't exist, pal. EXT. THE BUILDING - CONTINUOUS - DAY

Jasper grabs Max's arm to stop him; he towers over the twerp.

MAX Jasper, I gotta get out of here...now!

JASPER You're not going anywhere until you pay me back my money - pal!

Max is sweating now. He tries to wiggle away from Jasper, but Jasper is holding on tight.

MAX Jasper, you gotta let me go. There's some really bad people... (looks around) They'll kill me!

JASPER Not if I kill you first... you little prick!

Jasper twists Max's arm until it starts hurting...

MAX OK...OK...Listen...You can have my boat.

JASPER What kind of boat?

MAX

A sailboat.

JASPER

How big?

MAX Oh, it's big... A 62 foot Ocean sloop...

JASPER (suddenly very interested) Really?

MAX She's a beaut'. You'll love 'er. (pulls out the boat key and a file from the box) Here's the key and all her papers... Jasper releases Max to take the papers.

MAX (CONT'D) There's a buyer in Miami Beach who will buy it if you can get it there before he leaves on December 31. (climbs into his car) I gotta go...

Max pulls out of the parking lot and PEELS off.

Jasper watches Max take off with a million questions left unanswered. He looks at the key in his hand. He throws the key into the air, catches it and smiles broadly.

As he climbs into his car a black HUMMER slowly drives by and stops.

INT. THE HUMMER - CONTINUOUS

Papa Luigi watches Jasper from the passenger seat. Sal drives and Tony watches from the back seat.

SAL Who's the gibbone in the cheap suit?

TONY Never seen him before.

PAPA LUIGI Follow 'im.

SAL

Why?

PAPA LUIGI (backhands Sal) So we can find out who he is!

SAL Aw! Papa, that hurt!

PAPA LUIGI Don't ask so many questions the next time. Go!

EXT. CITY STREET - DAY

As Jasper pulls out of the parking lot, the Hummer follows.

CUT TO:

Trip and his buddies, BRAD and DIXON, exit the movie theater.

DIXON Oh, my God, Trip, there's Isabelle...What're you goin' do?

ANGLE ON

Four YOUNG GIRLS loitering in front of the movie theater, including ISABELLE, a pretty 13 year old.

TRIP Follow me...and learn.

The crew follows Trip as he walks by the girls. The girls turn to stare at the boys, who keep on walking without saying a word.

Isabelle breaks from the group of girls to catch up with Trip.

ISABELLE

Hi, Trip.

TRIP Hey, Isabelle.

ISABELLE Did you like the movie, Trip?

TRIP Awesome! Best one yet.

ISABELLE I thought so, too. We're going to The Burger Stop. Wanna come?

The crew is suddenly very excited, while Trip remains calm.

TRIP

Sure. Let's go.

Dixon and Brad exchange looks, truly amazed and impressed.
